- Π , π πόλις 'city, city-state'
- P, ρ ἡυθμός 'motion, rhythm'

T, τ τέλος 'end, ending, final moment; goal, completion, fulfillment; coming full circle, rounding out; successfully passing through an ordeal; initiation; ritual, rite'

Φ, φ φίλος 'friend' (noun); 'dear, near-and-dear, belonging to self' (adjective)

X, χ χορός 'chorus' = 'group of singers/dancers'
